

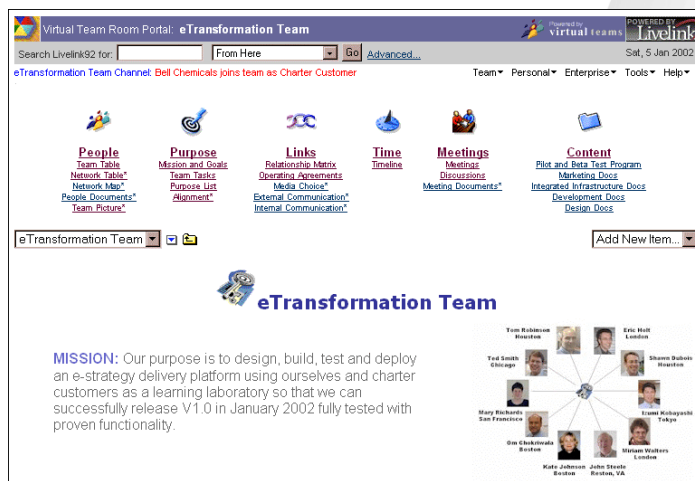

Features
